- 1. Applicant was a rostered player on a GBN Athletic Team for a minimum of 3 years.
- Applicants must submit a letter of recommendation from a Glenbard North teacher or coach.
- 3. The applicant must be considered in good standing with the Glenbard North Athletic Department. Factors that will be considered include eligibility, discipline, and extracurricular code of conduct.
- 4. The applicant is required to include the personal statement not to exceed two pages outlining "How has athletics impacted your life and your experiences at Glenbard North HS?
- 5. Parent must be a member in good standing with the GBN Athletic Boosters as of 3/08/2024.

Definition of a member in good standing:

- Completed the required 5 volunteer hours of each season in each year which their child plays a sport.
 (ex. football-5 hours, basketball-5 hours, track-5 hours)
- Current paid member of the GBN Athletic Boosters (Membership must be secured prior to 1/1/2024).
- Parent/Guardian must be a Athletic Booster Club member for 3 school years.
